

Program Highlights

- Goodwill of the Southern Alleghenies, Inc. replaces Goodwill Industries of Conemaugh Valley, Inc. as the organizational name.
- Along with key stakeholders, Goodwill established the Cambria County Expungement Collaborative to assist residents seeking to have non-convictions removed from their records.
- Goodwill was awarded a contract to provide pre- and post-release services to ex-offenders currently incarcerated in state correctional institutions (SCIs).
- Through Goodwill Industries International, our Goodwill received a Department of Labor subgrant to serve young ex-offenders along with Austin, Houston, New Orleans, and Detroit.
- As of July 1, 2017, Goodwill became the lead operator of the PA CareerLink® centers across a six-county region.
- Based on community needs assessment data, Goodwill provided leadership and coordination of a Cambria county-wide initiative to address community health issues including social economic factors.
- Along with key partners, Goodwill hosted a Quality of Life Summit in May 2017. Life domains continue to meet to address service gaps and redundancies.
- In partnership with the Pennsylvania Highlands Community College, Goodwill established Helms Academy that provides on-line high school diploma, GED, and credit-based college
